confirms the right to use the waters of LEO MATNEY WELL No. 1 a tributary of LOST RIVER for IRRIGATION of 27.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-557. The date of priority is MAY 9, 1957. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
