 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRED SCHULZE
 ROUTE 4, BOX 685
 ROSEBURG, OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of the LOOKINGGLASS CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 12.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-25902. The date of priority is DECEMBER 17, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.154 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of water in the South Umpqua River is 60.0 CFS or more at its mouth.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
