confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit R-2286. The amount of water stored to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: THE RIGHT TO STORE WATERS IN RESERVOIR #1 FROM UNNAMED INTERMITTENT FLOW CHANNELS AND THE OVERFLOW WATERS FROM RESERVOIR #2 UNDER APPLICATION R-34491, TRIBUTARIES OF LOST RIVER, AND THE RIGHT TO STORE WATERS IN RESERVOIR #3 FROM WRIGHT CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF THE LOST RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: STORAGE FOR MULTIPLE PURPOSES

MAXIMUM RATE: 19.8 ACRE FEET (AF), BEING 9.3 AF IN RESERVOIR #1 AND 10.5 AF IN RESERVOIR #3

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 19, 1959

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 21, 2011, at Special Order Volume 85, Page 839, approving Transfer Application T-10425, supersedes Certificate 34770, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
