CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-10645. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: WELL 1, WELL 2, AND WELL 3 IN THE COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 3.15 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) FROM WELL 1 AND WELL 3 WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN SUPPLY TO BE FURNISHED FROM WELL 2

DATE OF PRIORITY: MAY 7, 1986 FOR 0.03 CFS AND JULY 21, 1986 FOR 0.01 CFS

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotations system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which such right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of appropriation (Well 3 WASC 51988), together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.


Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device approved by the Director at each new and existing point of appropriation in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring device are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 9, 2015, at Special Order Volume 98, Page 66, approving Transfer Application T-11962, supersedes Certificate 65985, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
