CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRED B. GRABHORN RT 1 BOX 844 BEAVERTON, OR 97005

confirms the right to use the waters of a RESERVOIR, constructed under Application R-49470, Permit R-6019, a tributary the TUALATIN RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 24.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-37057. The date of priority is JULY 19, 1972. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 10.5 ACRE-FEET stored water only, or its equivalent, in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior rights existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate describes the portion of Certificate 41911 NOT modified by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 118, Page \(\to \oldot\) approving a partial cancellation. This certificate supersedes Certificate 41911.

This certificate also corrects a scrivener's error in the section number referenced in the measured distances description for the point of diversion.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
