CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-33691. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: LONE ROCK CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF ROCK CREEK

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 18.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JUNE 17, 1968

The points of diversion are located as follows:

5 S	23 E	WM	25	NW SW	NEW DIVERSION (ADDITIONAL) - 1530 FEET NORTH AND 1160 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 25

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device approved by the Director in good working order at each (new and existing) point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION and change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 24, 2015, at Special Order Volume 95, Page 299, approving Transfer Application T-11768, and together with Certificate 90071, supersedes Certificate 37917, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
