confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE WILLOW CREEK, a tributary to WILLOW CREEK for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, LIVESTOCK AND DOMESTIC of 1.7 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 426. The date of priority is 1906.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.04 CFS from February 15th to May 1st and 0.02 CFS from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation, the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 5.1 acre feet.
