CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certify, That SAM AKLIN
of Halfway , State of Oregon , has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the
waters of Pine Creek , a tributary of Snake River
, for the purpose of the irrigation of 72 acres of land and domestic use
under Permit No. 1756 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered
of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1,
at page 191 , on the 1st day of September, 1915 ; that the priority of
the right hereby confirmed dates from September 11, 1913 ; that the amount of
water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not
exceed 1.00 cubic feet per second. The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Office. A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
let Five (5) of Section Nine (9): 4 agres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 1 agre in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 1 agre in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Eight (8), Township Seven (7) South, Range Forty-eight (48) East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon. The appropriation for irrigation purposes is hereby limited to one-lightieth of one cubic foot/for each agre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of rotes.
nd one-tenth cubic foot per second for domestic use. The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the
Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
