CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-7433. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL A TRIBUTARY OF COX CREEK

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 24.7 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.31 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 15, 1977

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by a proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Measurement use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 17, 2011, at Special Order Volume 83, Page 830, approving Transfer Application T-11173, and together with Certificate 86872, supercedes Certificate 55094, State record of Water Right Certificates.
