confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-4107. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: STANBRO RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-451, CERTIFICATE 4936

PURPOSE OR USE: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 35.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.44 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MAY 2, 1919

Stanbro Reservoir is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or measuring devices in good working order, at each point of diversion (new and existing).

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 12, 2016 at Special Order Volume 101, Page 900, approving Transfer Application T-12129, and together with Certificate 91880, supercedes Certificate 4931, State record of Water Right Certificates.
