confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-2490. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: HORSE HEAVEN CREEK AND MEADOW, BRANCH OF HORSE HAVEN CREEK

PURPOSE OR USE: THE IRRIGATION OF 24.0 ACRES OF LAND

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 13, 1915

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

Water use measurement conditions:


- A. The water user shall maintain the weir or measuring devices in good working order, at each new point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screens at the new points of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 11, 2016, at Special Order Volume 101, Page 697, approving Transfer Application T-12122, and together with Certificate 91770, supercedes Certificate 1828, State record of Water Right Certificates.
