CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK LAKE CREEK, TRIBUTARY TO METOLIUS RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 1.4 ACRES, DOMESTIC, AND LIVESTOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 9, at Page 362. The date of priority is 1888.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

13 S	9 E	WM	15	NW NW	440 FEET SOUTH AND 350 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 15

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from May 1 to September 15 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 8, 2015, at Special Order Volume 95, Page 653, approving Transfer Application 11964, and together with Certificate 90290, supercedes Certificate 88448, State record of Water Right Certificates.
