CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FARMERS IRRIGATION DISTRICT 1985 COUNTRY CLUB RD HOOD RIVER, OR 97031

confirms the right to use the waters of RAINY CREEK, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY TO BE MADE UP FROM GATE CREEK, CABIN CREEK, DITCH CREEK AND DEADPOINT CREEK, UPPER AND LOWER GREENPOINT RESERVOIRS CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-698, tributaries of the HOOD RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 147.85 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-51189. The date of priority is APRIL 27, 1989.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.85 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the sources.

Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate also corrects scrivener's errors in the measured distances descriptions for the points of diversion for Gate and Cabin Creeks.

This certificate supersedes Certificate 76230.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm portions of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
