CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRED B. GRABHORN  
RT 1  
BEAVERTON, OR 97005

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED CREEK, a tributary the TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 6.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-21093. The date of priority is February 14, 1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.086 cubic foot per second or its equivalent, in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q
2 S	1 W	WM	7	SW NW

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate supersedes Certificate 23061.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
