confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-10925. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL IN FORT ROCK VALLEY BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 9.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 4, 1989

The well is located as follows:

26 S	18 E	WM	14	SW NW	1340 FEET SOUTH AND 1341 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation described as follows:

26 S	17 E	WM	25	NW NW	1320 FEET SOUTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 25

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. Water user shall maintain a suitable measuring device, and continue to keep a complete record of the amount of groundwater withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 11, 2004, at Special Order Volume 61, Page 192, approving Transfer Application T-8925, and together with Certificate 80779, supersedes the Proof to Satisfaction of the Director for T-8021 (Special Order Volume 52, Page 821).
