confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, a tributary of the SANTIAM RIVER for IRRIGATION of 5.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Marion County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 18, at Page 437. The date of priority is MAY 14, 1909.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

Note: To compensate for losses between the point of diversion to the place of use, an additional amount not exceeding ten percent is allowed.

The point of diversion is located as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
