CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the CROOKED RIVER, tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat, other ecological values, and pollution abatement.

This right was perfected under Permit S-33954. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 18, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 5.99 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, and is further limited to an annual volume of 2,542.72 ACRE FEET, measured at OWRD Gauging Station #14087300, from APRIL 1 through OCTOBER 31 of each year.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion previously authorized under Certificate 90177, located at approximately RM 27.5:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
14 S	13 E	WM	13	SW NE	590 FEET NORTH AND 2790 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 13

To the mouth at River Mile 0.0, located at the confluence with the Deschutes River.

Water rights upstream of the original point of diversion shall not be subject to regulation for flows in excess of the quantity to which this instream water right is entitled at the original point of diversion.

Within the specified stream reach, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion.


This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The instream right established by this allocation of conserved water shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346, and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470 unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 90177 and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 118, Page 173, approving Conserved Water Application CW-115.
