CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of HATCHERY CREEK, a tributary of WILSON RIVER for Domestic use 4 families.

This right was perfected under Permit S-22798. The date of priority is February 4, 1954. That the amount of water to which this right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q
1 S	8 W	WM	7	SW SE

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q
1 S	8 W	WM	18	NW NE

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Lot 9, 1 house; Lot 10, 1 house; Lots 12 and 13, 1 house; Lot 18, 1 house; Reeher's Tracts.


This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 2, 2020, at Special Order Volume 118, Page 130, and together with Certificate 95498, supersedes Certificate 24351, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
