CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BADGER VENTURES LLC

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE WELLS in the CROW CAMP CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 125.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2343. The date of priority is JANUARY 14, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at each point of appropriation (new and existing) in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate the interference.

The water user shall ensure that the well has been assigned an OWRD Well Identification Number (Well ID tag), which shall be permanently attached to the well. The Well ID shall be used as a reference in any correspondence regarding the well, including any reports of water use, water level, or pump test data.


Dedicated Measuring Tube: Wells with pumps shall be equipped with a minimum ¾-inch diameter, unobstructed, dedicated measuring tube pursuant to figure 200-5 in OAR 690-200.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 94574, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 02 2021, approving Transfer Application T-13346.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
