confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-17667. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: PALMER CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF BIG APPLGATE, A TRIBUTARY OF ROGUE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); BEING 0.09 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.01 CFS FOR DOMESTIC

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 7, 1947

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meters or other suitable measuring devices, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of diversion (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND ADDITIONAL POINTS OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 27, 2015, at Special Order Volume 95, Page 159, approving Transfer Application T-11726, supercedes Certificate 19687, State record of Water Right Certificates.
