confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-36319. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: AN UNNAMED SPRING, A TRIBUTARY OF LUCKIAMUTE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: NURSERY USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JUNE 28, 1971

The point of diversion is located as follows:

9 S	5 W	WM	22	NW SE	60	1350 FEET NORTH AND 1950 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 22

The Nursery use shall be limited as follows:

- a) The amount of water used for NURSERY OPERATIONS is limited to a rate of diversion of 0.01 cubic foot per second and 3.29 acre-feet per each acre per year.
- b) For the irrigation of containerized nursery plants, the amount of water diverted is limited to 0.01 cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.29 acre feet per each acre per year.
- c) For the irrigation of in-ground nursery plants, the amount of water diverted is limited to 0.01 cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.29 acre feet per each acre per year.
- d) For irrigation of any other crop, the amount of water diverted is limited to 0.01 cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre feet per each acre during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 13, 2018, at Special Order Volume 107, Page 1092, approving Transfer Application T-12422, supercedes Certificate 41573, State record of Water Right Certificates.
