 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J. E. LARKIN
 RT 1 BOX 45 A
 MONROE, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of HAMMER CREEK and an UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of MARYS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 52.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-20350. The date of priority is MAY 18, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.645 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


