CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHESTER PRIOR, EAGLE RANCH
32327 OREGON TRAIL RD
ECHO, OR 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary COLUMBIA RIVER, for PRIMARY IRRIGATION of 72.6 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 2814.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-48450. The date of priority is AUGUST 3, 1981. This right is limited to 72.18 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The use allowed herein may be made anytime between November 15 and June 15 of each year that water can be put to beneficial use by irrigation, either for immediate crop growth or for forecast requirements to raise the soil moisture to field capacity in the soil profile to be utilized by plant growth in the subsequent growing season.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent), and 1.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the period from November 15 to the last day of February of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated in any one year, provided further, that the part declared herein be for supplemental irrigation, the right allowed may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply provided the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein. The use of water during the period from November 15 to the last day of February of each year shall not establish priority of rights against future appropriations for beneficial uses or storage for such beneficial uses, other than similar rights for irrigation from November 15 to the last day of February.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


In addition, this Certificate includes the portion of the originating water right Certificate 81815, NOT modified by Transfer T-9845.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
