CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HOWARD E. TRYON  
 ROUTE 2  
 DAYTON, OR 97114

confirms the right to use the waters of the YAMHILL RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION.

This right was perfected under Permit S-13897. The date of priority is JUNE 27, 1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent per acre for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

UNIT 113---Tract 75 (Howard E. Tryon)

A part of the tract of land situate in Section 18, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, and in Section 13, Township 4 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, in the Francis Fletcher Donation Land Claim No. 60 and No. 46, Notification No. 792, in Yamhill County, Oregon, conveyed to the United States by C.R. Burkhart by deed recorded October 25, 1937, in Book 113, page 308, of the Deed Records of Yamhill County, Oregon, and part being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the point marked by 3/4" iron pipe on the South line of United States Farm Security Administration Farm Unit No. 37 and at the most northerly Northeast corner of Farm Unit No. 112, said point being 92.37 feet North of and 2029.05 feet East of the Northeast corner of the Ahio S. Watt Donation Land Claim No. 78, Notification No. 1220;

Thence along the line common with Farm Unit No. 112 as follows: South 7 degrees 30' 18" East 1342.15 feet to a point marked by a 3/4 " iron pipe; South 89 degrees 09' 56" West 505.16 feet to a point marked by a 3/4 " iron pipe; North 80 degrees 06' 06" East 590.09 feet to a point marked by 3/4 " iron pipe; South 23 degrees 22' 30" East 124.16 feet to a point marked by a 3/4 " iron pipe set back on line 192.60 feet;

Thence along the low water line of the West bank of the Yamhill River as follows: North 23 Degrees 48' 10" West 119.27 feet to a point; North 2 degrees 49' 17" East 103.21 feet to a point; North 24 degrees 19' 33" East 590.45 feet to a point where a small creek intersects the said low water line of the Yamhill River;

Thence meandering the center line of the small creek as follows: North 78 degrees 58' 18" West 237.80 feet to a point; South 71 degrees 06' 02" West 323.39 feet to a point; North 82 degrees 35' 13" West 295.38 feet to a point marked by a 3/4 " iron pipe on the center line of the county road;

Thence North 89 degrees 22' 16" West 1635.29 feet along the line common with May B. Nelson property and the line common with Farm Unit No. 37 to the point of beginning;


This unit contains 56.720 acres, more or less.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 15091, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 08 2021, approving Transfer Application T-13275.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
