CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAR CREEK, a tributary of the Wallowa River, for MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, Pages 151 - 154. The date of priority is 1883 for Tract 1 and 1893 for Tract 2.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed the following, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion:

Priority	Period of Use	Rate (cfs)	Tract
1883	May 1 to July 31	2.00	1
1893	May 1 to July 31	1.30	12
1883	August 1 to October 1	0.67	1
1893	August 1 to October 1	0.43	12

The point of diversion is located as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This Certificate is issued to describe that portion of Certificate 2978 confirmed by Special Order Volume 1, Page 283 on July 10, 1926, not modified by Special Order Volume 50, Page 607 approving T-7479 or Special Order Volume 61, Page 10 approving T-8805, and together with Certificates 72348 and 80878 and Transfer T-1, supersedes Certificate 2978.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
