confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-1321. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS, A TRIBUTARY OF UMATILLA RIVER (COLUMBIA RIVER)

PURPOSE OR USE: MUNICIPAL

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.34 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 6, 1959

The wells are located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:


- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or measuring devices, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 22, 2013, at Special Order Volume 91, Page 518, approving Transfer Application T-11601, supercedes Certificate 37615, State record of Water Right Certificates.
