confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-10140. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS IN THE SPRAGUE RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 102.47 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.28 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 22, 1983

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The use may be regulated if analysis of date available discloses that the appropriation will measurable reduce surface water flows necessary to maintain the fee-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meters or measuring devices, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 28, 2018, at Special Order Volume 109, Page 223, approving Transfer Application T-12872, and together with Certificate 93864, supercedes Certificate 76361, State record of Water Right Certificates.
