CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR (constructed under Application No. R-38002, Permit No. R-3134), a tributary of DAIRY CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 8.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permits-28329. The date of priority is AUGUST 27, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-3143. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued to describe the right NOT modified by provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director, entered MAR 31 2021, and recorded in Special Order Volume 118, Pages 817-822, approving a partial cancellation the right evidenced by Certificate 34827. This certificate supersedes Certificate 34827.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
