CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-3470. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS, A TRIBUTARY OF CATHERINE CREEK

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 982.6 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 5.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 23, 1967

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 13, 2006 at Special Order Volume 68, Page 265, approving Transfer Application T-10026, supercedes Certificate 42441, State record of Water Right Certificates.
