confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-26498. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: AN UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIBUTARY OF ROGUE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: QUASI-MUNICIPAL

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: DECEMBER 7, 1959

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter, or another suitable measuring device as approved by the Director, at each point of diversion (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The use of water is under this right is limited to an annual volume of 4.0 acre-feet per year.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 18, 2015, at Special Order Volume 95, Page 765, approving Transfer Application 11802, supercedes Certificate 32303, State record of Water Right Certificates.
