CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ALLEN MAXFIELD 329 ISLAND AVE NEWPORT BEACH CA 92661

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLIAMSON RIVER, a tributary of UPPER KLAMATH LAKE for IRRIGATION of 4.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 23654. The date of priority is JUNE 30, 1955. This right is limited to 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the sources.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, the totalizing flow meter or suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, at each point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 27, 2015, at Special Order Volume 95, Page 885, approving Transfer Application 11919, supercedes Certificate 65750, State record of Water Right Certificates.
