confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-21745. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: WHITTIER RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION NO. R-27602, PERMIT R-1427, A TRIBUTARY OF EAST FORK WILLIAMS CREEK

PURPOSE OR USE: PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 5.5 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 2, 1952

The point of diversion is located as follows:

39 S	5 W	WM	2	SW SW	300 FEET NORTH AND 400 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SWSW, SECTION 2

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under permit No. R-1424; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitations allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 27, 2015, at Special Order Volume 95, Page 979, approving Transfer Application T- 11861, and together with Certificate 90224, supercedes Certificate 20339, State record of Water Right Certificates.
