CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of UMATILLA RIVER, TRIBUTARY TO THE COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 81.2 ACRES, DOMESTIC, AND STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 241. The date of priority is 1890 FOR 66.45 ACRES AND 1902 FOR 14.75 ACRES.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.83 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) FOR 1890 AND 0.185 CFS FOR 1902, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.

Water use measurement conditions:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each new point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the places of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in water use described in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 3, 2016, at Special Order Volume 100, Page 373, approving Transfer Application T-11738, and supercedes UMATILLA DECREE VOL. 3 PAGE 241, Order Record of the Water Resources Director.
