CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BERNARD B. AND GRACE G. FITZE
 COURTROCK RT
 MONUMENT OR 97864

confirms the right to use the waters of COTTONWOOD CREEK, a tributary of JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION of 8.4 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 12.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-40984. The date of priority is AUGUST 6, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.36 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate clarifies the location of the point of diversion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 47400, State Record of Water Right Certificates, described in the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 01 2021, approving Transfer Application T-10997, and supersedes Certificate 47400.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
