 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ORODELL CANAL COMPANY
 62876 MONROE LANE
 LA GRANDE, OR 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 544.1 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1872. The use is limited to three acre-feet per acre in any irrigation season diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully at the original point of diversion described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 93271, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 14 2021, approving Transfer Application T-12740.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
