## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM SHEROD WALLOWA, OR 97885

confirms the right to use the waters of the LOSTINE RIVER (aka SOUTH FORK WALLOWA RIVER), a tributary to the WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 191.5 ACRES, DOMESTIC, AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Page 193. The date of priority is 1883.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31 of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre foot per are during the entire remainder of the irrigation season.
