 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of DEER CREEK for IRRIGATION of 54.7 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at page 70. The date of priority is 1885 AND JULY 7, 1932 (see "NOTE" below).

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.094 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
38 S	8 W	WM	10	SE SW	830 FEET NORTH AND 1140 FEET WEST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 10

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTE: 0.571 cubic foot per second is awarded for the irrigation of the above described land with a priority date of July 7, 1932, in addition to that allowed above.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or measuring device in good working order, at the new point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted as required by the Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening and/or by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVISION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 8, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 581, approving Transfer Application T-10794, and together with Certificate 86182, supercedes Certificate 13831, State record of Water Right Certificates.
