confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-43279. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF THE UMPQUA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES, AND LIVESTOCK WATER

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.0024 CFS FOR STOCKWATER

DATE OF PRIORITY: MAY 18, 1978

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:


Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each new point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring devices; provided however, where the meter or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 30, 2015, at Special Order Volume 98, Page 538, approving Transfer Application T-12052, and together with Certificate 91125, supercedes Certificate 90075, State record of Water Right Certificates.
