CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H. K. FISHER
HAINES OR 97833

confirms the right to use the waters of ROCK CREEK, a tributary of the POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 120.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1879.

The use is limited to 1/40 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

J. K. FISHER AND A. LONG DITCHES FOR 120 ACRES

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 68433, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 30 2021, approving Transfer Application T- 13513, and together with Certificate 95712 supersedes Certificate 68433, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
