CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of FAIREY [FERRY] CREEK, tributary to the COQUILLE RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-8928. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 23, 1929. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, further limited to an annual volume of 724.0 ACRE-FEET.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 8265, located approximately:

To the mouth at River Mile 0.0. Due to tidal influence in this reach, measuring stream discharge for the purpose of monitoring this instream water right will be done at a suitable location determined by Department staff.

Within the specified stream reach, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion. Stream channel losses and gains calculated based on available data and the use of water by senior appropriators will determine the amount of water to which this right is entitled downstream from the original point of diversion within the specified stream reach.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
