CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under Permit S-902. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: GRANDE RONDE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF SNAKE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 119.5 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 302.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 6.01 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), FURTHER LIMITED TO 4.23 CFS FROM POD 1, 4.67 CFS FROM POD 2, 6.01 CFS FROM POD 3, AND 5.79 CFS FROM POD 4

DATE OF PRIORITY: JULY 25, 1911

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at each point of diversion.

The water user shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion as described in Certificates 79872, 79873, and 82074 as follows:


The right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 91331, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 16 2022, approving Transfer Application T-12712.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
