confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-9898. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS IN LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 65.8 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.82 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.5 CFS FOR PRIORITY DATE SEPTEMBER 7, 1978 AND 0.32 CFS FOR PRIORITY DATE OCTOBER 8, 1982

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 7, 1978 AND OCTOBER 8, 1982

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.


Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 29, 2005, at Special Order Volume 63, Page 505, approving Transfer Application T-9752, and together with Certificate 81166, supercedes Certificate 55415, State record of Water Right Certificates.
