NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 18, 2014, at Special Order Volume 91, Page 991, approving Transfer Application 11533, and together with Certificate 89125, supercedes Certificate 2458, State record of Water Right Certificates.
