## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DONALD BIEBERSTEDT PO BOX 6 EAGLE POINT, OR 97524

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK and KNUTZEN GULCH and RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION NO. R-26036, PERMIT NO. R-1222, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION.

This right was perfected under Permit S-20560. The date of priority is JUNE 13, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1222, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
