confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-44991. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: AN UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIBUTARY OF NORTH UMPQUA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ½ ACRE IN AREA

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: DECEMBER 28, 1979

The point of diversion is located as follows:

26 S	3 W	WM	3	NE SE	2200 FEET NORTH AND 1220 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 10

This right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 18, 2017, at Special Order Volume 105, Page 646, approving Transfer Application T-12419, and together with Certificate 93258, supercedes Certificate 58722, State record of Water Right Certificates.
