CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-39912. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: MILL CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF WILLOW CREEK

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 15.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.38 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 21, 1975

The points of diversion are located as follows:

1 S	38 E	WM	1	SW SW	POD 3 (ADDITIONAL) – 703.9 FEET NORTH AND 1971.36 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 12
1 S	38 E	WM	12	SE NW	POD 1 (ORIGINAL) – 60 FEET NORTH AND 40 FEET WEST FROM C1/4 CORNER, SECTION 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

1 S	38 E	WM	12	NW NE	15.0

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


If the Watermaster determines that the instream water right under Certificate 73317 is not being met and that water is available for the priority date of the right, the original points of diversion must be used.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE and an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 24, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 1133, approving Transfer Application T-8025, supercedes Certificate 46938, State record of Water Right Certificates.
