 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

COW CREEK BAND OF THE UMPQUA INDIANS

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-7528. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF THE UMPQUA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 9.5 ACRES AND COMMERCIAL USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

THE COMMERCIAL USE UNDER THIS RIGHT IS LIMITED TO A RATE OF DIVERSION OF 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND AN ANNUAL VOLUME OF 14.4 ACRE-FEET DURING THE PERIOD OF MARCH 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR.

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 20, 1926

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

29 S	5 W	WM	7	SE SW	NORTH 85 DEGREES 36 MINUTES EAST, 2660 FEET FROM SW CORNER OF SECTION 7

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring devices at each point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.


The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 19, 2010, at Special Order Volume 81, Page 726, approving Transfer Application T-8039, and together with Certificate 86500, supercedes Certificate 73635, State record of Water Right Certificates.
