CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-30408. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: COAST FORK WILLAMETTE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF WILLAMETTE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 4.5 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.057 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 29, 1965

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.


Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meters or another suitable measuring devices, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at the new point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or the place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 6, 2018, at Special Order Volume 107, Page 643, approving Transfer Application T-12624, and together with Certificate 93601, supercedes Certificate 35649, State record of Water Right Certificates.
