DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 25, 1929



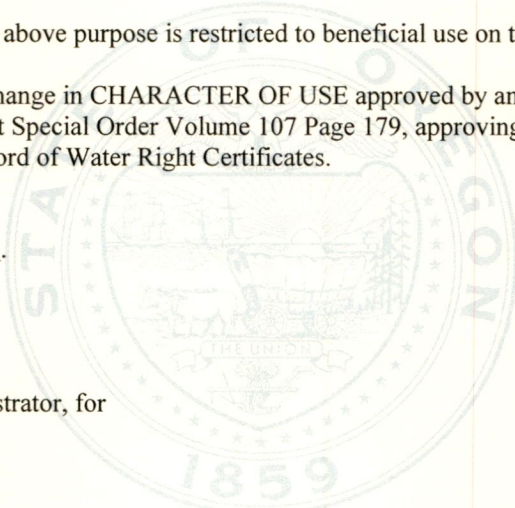
The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.
