- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meters or other suitable measuring devices as approved by the Director in good working order at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation (Well S and Well T), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Well 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation (Well 2).

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation (Well 2).

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirms changes in ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 8, 2020, at Special Order Volume 114, Page 185, approving Transfer Application T-12289, supersedes Certificate 53123, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
